RESOLUTION NO. 1820

A RESOLUTION OF THE GOLDEN CITY COUNCIL SUPPORTING EFFORTS TO SAFEGUARD PUBLIC HEALTH FROM THE HARMFUL EFFECTS OF OZONE POLLUTION

- WHEREAS, during the summer of 2007 ground-level ozone concentrations in the Denver metropolitan region violated current federal health standards on numerous days; and
- WHEREAS, ground-level ozone is a key ingredient of smog and is a corrosive air pollutant that especially endangers children, seniors, those with asthma and other respiratory conditions, and active adults; and
- WHEREAS, clean air is a hallmark of economic vitality and sustainability, and a keystone of healthy and safe communities in the City of Golden; and
- WHEREAS, one of the City of Golden Comprehensive Plan's goals is to "Control the creation and adverse effects of pollution;"
- WHEREAS, one of the City of Golden Comprehensive Plan's identified Strategies and Actions is "Coordination and cooperation with Jefferson County, regional, state, and Federal agencies; and
- WHEREAS, science advisors to the federal government, public health organizations, physicians, and researchers from throughout the country are in agreement that stronger health standards for ground-level ozone are needed; and
- WHEREAS, at the urging of the Colorado Governor, state and regional air quality planners are moving to develop a plan that reduces ground-level ozone to safeguard the public health across the Denver Metropolitan region.
- THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:
- <u>Section 1.</u> The Golden City Council hereby supports the efforts of state and regional air quality planners to immediately develop a plan to reduce ground-level ozone and fully safeguard public health in the Denver metropolitan region.
- Section 2. That copies of this resolution be transmitted to the Regional Air Quality Council and Colorado Governor Bill Ritter.
