RESOLUTION NO. 2039

A RESOLUTION OF THE GOLDEN CITY COUNCIL ACCEPTING A DEDICATION OF LAND FOR A POTENTIAL ROADWAY, AND ACKNOWLEDGING THE SATISFACTION OF CONDITIONS IMPOSED BY ORDINANCE 1697

WHEREAS, on April 14, 2005 the Golden City Council approved Ordinance 1697, which ordinance conditionally approved a vacation of a portion of Maple Street, a portion of 16th Street, and the alley located within Block 77 of the plat of the south side of Clear Creek; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 1697 authorized the closure of said street segments, but required the satisfaction of certain conditions before the right of way vacations would go into effect; and

WHEREAS, on July 24, 2008 City Council adopted Ordinance 1817 reenacting in part Ordinance 1697 and amending Section 3 of the ordinance to extend the period for compliance until December 31, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the Colorado School of Mines submitted a roadway "easement" prior to December 31, 2009 to satisfy the remaining condition, and subsequently, at the request of the City, submitted the Dedication document attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the Colorado School of Mines initially complied with the requirements for closure of the streets, and has now delivered dedication documents, which are necessary to satisfy the conditions for the subject right of way vacations to go into effect; and

WHEREAS, City Council has considered the land dedication to the City of Golden.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. City Council accepts the dedication of fee title to the property, substantially in the form attached hereto as Exhibits A. The Mayor is authorized to acknowledge the City's acceptance of the dedication.

Section 2. Pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance 1697, City Council hereby finds that all of the conditions of Ordinance 1697 have been and the Mayor is authorized to execute a recordable "Certificate" to document that the right of way vacations authorized by Ordinance 1697 are fully effective.

Said dedication being subject to the right of the Dedicator to continue to access and use the property for such purposes that the property is currently used by the Dedicator, at no cost to the Dedicator, including, but not limited to the maintenance of all existing improvements, equipment, structures, and landscaping on the property until such time as Golden commences construction activities for a municipal street or other appurtenant uses.


