## **RESOLUTION NO. 1741**

## A RESOLUTION OF THE GOLDEN CITY COUNCIL DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO DELAY THE DOG LICENSING PROGRAM UNTIL APRIL 1, 2007

WHEREAS, on October 26, 2006 City Council, by Ordinance No. 1748 established a Dog Licensing Program for the City of Golden; and

WHEREAS, the Dog Licensing Program was to be administered by Jefferson county with all licensing revenue, except a small maintenance cost, to be used for capital improvements at the Table Mountain Animal Center (TMAC); and

WHEREAS, although City Council anticipated a January 1, 2007 start date, Jefferson County is not ready to handle this expansion.

THEREFORE, BE IS RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. The City Manager is directed to delay the imposition of the Dog Licensing Program until April 1, 2007.

<u>Section 2</u>. The Council asks Jefferson County and the other municipalities to designate this program as a very high priority because of the critical needs at TMAC.
