

RESOLUTION NO. 1656

**A RESOLUTION OF THE GOLDEN CITY COUNCIL CALLING  
FOR A SPECIAL ELECTION ON APRIL 25, 2006 TO ELECT A  
COUNCILOR IN WARD 2 TO SERVE THE REMAINING TERM  
OF A VACATED COUNCIL SEAT**

WHEREAS, the Councilor from Ward 2 resigned at the conclusion of the City Council Study Session on February 2, 2006 and has announced his resignation effective upon the date when his successor is duly elected at the April 25, 2006 special election; and

WHEREAS, Section 3.7 of the City's Home Rule Charter provides that if a vacancy occurs in an elective office with a remaining unexpired term exceeding 180 days from the date of the vacancy, then the remaining Councilors shall, by resolution, call for a special election to elect a duly qualified successor provided there not be a general election within 180 days; and

WHEREAS, the Council offices for Ward 2 shall be vacant, with a remaining unexpired term exceeding 180 days from the date of such vacancy and a general election is not scheduled to take place within 180 days of such vacancy; and

WHEREAS, City Council declares that the special election shall not be held within 40 days of passage of this resolution.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO :


Section 1. In accordance with Section 3.7 and 4.3 of the City of Golden's Home Rule Charter, there shall be conducted a special election on Tuesday, April 25, 2006 to fill the remainder of the terms for the Council position vacated in Ward 2.

Section 2. The election shall be conducted in accordance with the Colorado Municipal Election Code of 1965.


Section 3. The polling place for Ward 2 shall be located at Fire Station Four 151 Heritage Road.

Section 4. The City Clerk shall cause a Notice of Election to be filed as required by law.



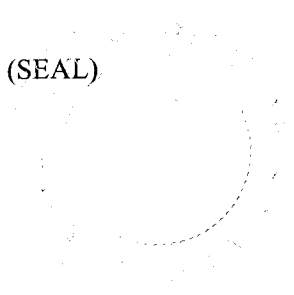
