RESOLUTION NO. 1771

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN AUTHORIZING THE HIRING OF A SPECIAL LEGAL COUNSEL REGARDING LITIGATION FILED AGAINST THE CITY BY MARY WEAVER

WHEREAS, Section 9.1 of the Home Rule Charter authorizes City Council to appoint special counsel; and

WHEREAS, on May 10, 2007, Councilor Weaver filed a lawsuit naming the City, the remaining current Councilmembers, the City Attorney, the City Manager; and the City Clerk as Defendants.

WHEREAS, because the Complaint names the City Attorney as a Defendant, it would inappropriate for the City Attorney, or other attorneys in his office, to provide representation with respect to the Complaint, and it is therefore necessary to appoint special counsel; and

WHEREAS, the City insurance carrier, CIRSA, will provide limited defense coverage of the litigation and has appointed Thomas Lyons of Hall and Evans for that purpose; and

WHEREAS, City Council now wishes to appoint special counsel for the purpose of providing legal representation on the pending litigation to the extent that representation is required beyond that provided by CIRSA, and to establish compensation for such special counsel.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

As provided by Section 9.1 of the City of Golden's Home Rule Charter, Council does hereby appoint Thomas Lyons and the law firm of Hall and Evans as special counsel at the hourly rate of \$150.00.
