

RESOLUTION NO. 2050

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO, APPOINTING SPECIAL COUNSEL TO REPRESENT THE CITY IN LITIGATION CONCERNING A FORMER EMPLOYEES DISABILITY CLAIM

WHEREAS, Section 9.1 of the City's Home Rule Charter authorizes City Council to appoint special counsel; and

WHEREAS, on April 2, 2010 a former employee filed suit in United States District Court against the City and its prior benefits provider alleging that the employee was improperly denied disability benefits; and

WHEREAS, CIRSA does not provide coverage for such claims; and


WHEREAS, given the specialized nature of this litigation both CIRSA and the City Attorney's Office recommends that Council appoint special counsel to represent the City: and

WHEREAS, Andrew Nathan of Nathan, Bremer, Dumm & Meyers P.C. has litigation experience in benefits and is highly recommended by both CIRSA and the City Attorney's Office.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:






