Dear Mr. Proett:

As you know our office acts as general counsel to the City of Golden, Colorado. The City has had an opportunity for its surveyor to locate the wastewater facilities that is the subject of your February 14, 2005 letter to James Windholz. Attached please find two exhibit maps prepared by our surveyor that indicates that the manhole appears to encroach past the easement over the Tripp's property by less than 1 foot. The total area of the encroachment appears to be less than 2 ½ square feet.

As full and final settlement of any claims your clients may have to this alleged encroachment, the City will offer to pay to the Tripp's \$100.00. This far exceeds the market value of the area of the encroachment. Alternatively, if it is your client's desire, the City will move the manhole such that it is located completely within the boundaries of the easement and restore the property outside the boundaries of the easement to substantially the condition as it existed to the installation of the manhole.

If you will advise me of which option the Tripp's prefer I will draft the appropriate release for their execution. If you have any questions please let me know.
