## **RESOLUTION NO. 1955**

A RESOLUTION OF THE GOLDEN CITY COUNCIL PROVIDING DIRECTION REGARDING THE DESIGN OF PEDESTRIAN, BICYCLE, AND ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS FOR THE JACKSON CORRIDOR

WHEREAS, beginning in the 1990's, City Council directed that the City consider improvements to the Jackson Street corridor between downtown Golden and about 24<sup>th</sup> Street to improve pedestrian and bicycle conditions; and

WHEREAS, several public discussions and open houses have been held over the years to consider the design of such improvements; and

WHEREAS, the Golden Bicycle Master Plan adopted in 2003, and the Walkability Task Force report and Bicycle Master Plan Update Task Force report presented to City Council in 2008 all recommend that the design of Jackson Street include a two through lane cross section (similar to Ford Street), and that additional area be devoted to pedestrian, bicycle, parking, and turn lane facilities; and

WHEREAS, City Council authorized another open house discussion on February 11, 2009, and accepted public comment during the City Council meeting on February 26, 2009.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

City Council hereby authorizes the preparation of final design drawings and construction plans for the Jackson Street corridor, utilizing the design concept of two through vehicle lanes with associated pedestrian, bicycle, parking, and turn lane facilities. Refined designs of the corridor are to be presented to City Council prior to any release of formal bids for construction, currently anticipated for 2010.
