THIS AMENDED AGREEMENT entered into this May of November, 2007 by and between the City of Golden, Colorado, a municipal corporation ("City") and the Golden Landmarks Association, a Colorado non-profit corporation ("GLA") to extend the agreement signed November 14th, 2002 and all conditions contained therein. The following additions will apply:

- 1. <u>Term</u>. GLA hereby grants the City loan of the Collection of historic artifacts housed at the Astor House Museum and Clear Creek History Park until December 31, 2008, or until this Agreement is extended or terminated.
- 2. Entire Agreement. The parties acknowledge that this Agreement is intended to be an extension with attachments to the previous agreement effective January 1, 2003.
- 3. Compensation. The City will provide an operating grant in the amount of \$7500 per year, for the term of this Agreement. The grant shall be paid in two (2) equal installments, the first on or before January 31 and the second on or before July 31 of each year.
