**A RESOLUTION OF THE GOLDEN CITY COUNCIL IN
SUPPORT OF AMENDMENT 59, THE SAVINGS ACCOUNT
FOR EDUCATION INITIATIVE**

WHEREAS, Investing in education is the single best way to strengthen Colorado's economy, because good schools attract employers who bring family-wage jobs; and

WHEREAS, Investing in education is a cornerstone of a healthy community and healthy families; and

WHEREAS, Colorado's schools have faced ongoing and significant funding challenges, which Amendment 59 addresses by creating a needed savings account for preschool through 12th grade (P-12) education; and

WHEREAS, Amendment 59 forces government to save in the good times so that there is money in periods of economic downturn; and

WHEREAS, Amendment 59 has accountability mechanisms to ensure the savings account is safeguarded, and can only be used on a specific list of things that help student achievement; and


WHEREAS, Amendment 59 preserves the right to vote on taxes and preserves the constitutional requirement to balance the budget; and

Section 1. That the City Council supports Amendment 59, the Savings Account for Education Initiative, and support its passage at the November 4, 2008 General Election.


