RESOLUTION NO. 2130

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN ESTABLISHING A LINE OF SUCCESSION FOR THE OFFICE OF MAYOR IN THE ABSENCE OR DISABILITY OF THE MAYOR AND MAYOR PRO-TEM

WHEREAS, Section 3.6 of the Charter for the City of Golden provides that, in the absence or disability of the Mayor, the Mayor Pro-Tem shall perform all duties and have all powers of the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, the Charter does not specify a line of succession for performing the duties and exercising the powers of the Mayor in the event of the absence or disability of both the Mayor and the Mayor Pro-Tem; and

WHEREAS, City Council wishes to establish a line of succession for a City Councilor to perform all duties and have all powers of the Mayor in the event of the absence or disability of both the Mayor and Mayor Pro-Tem.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. In the event of the absence or disability of both the Mayor and the Mayor Pro-Tem, the City Councilor having served in office the longest at the time of such absence or disability shall be authorized to perform all duties and have all powers of the Mayor. Should the longest serving City Councilor also be unavailable due to absence or disability, such line of succession to perform all duties and have all powers of the Mayor shall continue to the next-longest serving and available City Councilor.
