

RESOLUTION NO. 2214

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN AUTHORIZING THAT VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION NUMBER INSPECTION FEES BE RECORDED AS REVENUE INTO THE CITY OF GOLDEN'S GENERAL FUND

WHEREAS, City of Golden police officers perform vehicle identification number (VIN) inspections; and

WHEREAS, the City charges a \$20 fee for VIN inspections pursuant to Colorado Revised Statutes (C.R.S.) 42-5-204; and

WHEREAS, the cost to the City to perform these VIN inspections is greater than the fee charged for the service; and

WHEREAS, C.R.S. 42-5-204 allows the governing body of the local government, by resolution, to order that the inspection fees be paid into the general fund of the local government.


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. That the current balance in the Certified VIN Fund deferred revenue account be paid into the General Fund revenues of the City.

Section 2. That all future VIN inspection fees collected by the City be paid directly into the General Fund revenues of the City.


