**A RESOLUTION OF THE GOLDEN CITY COUNCIL TO ADOPT  
THE "CLEAR CREEK MASTER PLAN" AS A TOOL TO  
DEFINE THE VISION FOR THE FUTURE OF THE CLEAR  
CREEK CORRIDOR IN THE CITY OF GOLDEN**

WHEREAS, The Clear Creek Corridor flows through the heart of Golden; and

WHEREAS, The Clear Creek Corridor includes Lions, History, Parfet and Vanover Parks, and the areas between these parks along Clear Creek; and

WHEREAS, The Golden Parks and Recreation Master Plan identifies a goal to develop a comprehensive Master Plan specific to this creek corridor; and

WHEREAS, The Clear Creek Corridor Master Plan strives to enhance parkland and expand recreation opportunities, create a continuous integrated corridor, establish a cohesive, dynamic character that builds upon the historic, natural, and urban contexts, improve multi-modal circulation and parking, reduce user conflicts, improve opportunities for special events and on-going programmed activities, and ensure, via the public involvement process that the corridor is a source of community pride.


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:


1. The Golden City Council approves the Golden Parks and Recreation Advisory Board and staff's recommendation to adopt the "Clear Creek Corridor Master Plan."


