**A RESOLUTION OF THE GOLDEN CITY COUNCIL
AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF GOLDEN TO APPLY FOR THE
2013-2014 GAMING GRANT CYCLE FROM THE LOCAL
GOVERNMENT LIMITED GAMING IMPACT FUND**

WHEREAS, the State of Colorado Department of Local Affairs (DOLA) has set May 30, 2013 as the deadline for impacted local governments to apply for 2013-2014 grants from the Local Government Limited Gaming Impact Fund; and

WHEREAS, the City of Golden is significantly impacted by traffic to and from the gaming centers of Central City and Blackhawk; and

WHEREAS, much of that impact occurs along US Highway 6 through the Clear Creek Canyon which is outside of the Golden city limits; and


WHEREAS, the citizens of Golden should not have to bear the financial impact of emergency response for gaming-related activity; and

WHEREAS, the City of Golden has always received funding from the Gaming Impact Fund.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO THAT:


City Council authorizes the City of Golden to apply for Gaming Grant funding for the 2013-2014 cycle.




