

RESOLUTION NO. 2193

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN ACCEPTING A REPORT OF FINAL RECOMMENDATIONS FROM THE RENEWABLE ENERGY TECHNICAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE AND PROVIDING DIRECTION THEREON

WHEREAS, the Golden City Council launched the Golden Sustainability Initiative in 2007; and

WHEREAS, the City of Golden has made substantial progress on some of the Sustainability Initiative goals and wished to increase its focus on the renewable energy goals specifically; and

WHEREAS, the Golden City Council created the Renewable Energy Technical Advisory Committee (RETAC) through Resolution No. 2174 on December 8, 2011 to receive expert recommendations on how to fulfill the renewable goals; and

WHEREAS, RETAC met regularly through the Spring of 2012, with the Community Sustainability Advisory Board on May 30, 2012, and presented its recommendations to City Council on May 10, 2012.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. City Council gratefully accepts the RETAC Report and Recommendations, as presented to City Council on June 14, 2012. The Committee is to be commended for their diligent effort and well thought out recommendations that will substantially benefit the Golden community. Council expresses its sincere thanks and gratitude for the technical review effort.


Section 3. City Council commits to discuss and consider the prioritized policy recommendations contained in the Report in a timely manner.

Section 4. Per the provisions of Section 11 of Resolution 2174, pertaining to the termination of the task force, City Council hereby concludes the Committee's obligation.


